Dear 5th Grade Families:

Our classes are about to study an important lesson on the early stages of puberty, which many 5th graders are beginning to experience.

The Always Changing Program helps both boys and girls:

- Understand the physical and emotional changes they experience during puberty, and acknowledge these changes as a normal part of growth and development.
- Learn the physiology of their bodies and correct terminology for parts of the reproductive system.
- Understand that personal hygiene is each individual's responsibility.

In addition, the program helps girls:

- Understand the menstrual cycle.
- Understand what to expect during a period.
- Learn how to manage periods while continuing with normal activities.

The *Always Changing Program* will be taught to the students on April 29, 2011. Mrs. Kendra Selser RN, School Nurse and Mrs. Cheryl McCauley will meet with the girls. Mr. Marc McCauley and Mr. Ron Silvers will meet with the boys.
