Extreme Weather

In times of extreme weather, please remember the following:

- Make sure your child is dressed for the weather.
- Do not leave your child unattended at the bus stop.
- Know buses will be at the first stop on time, Mother Nature has control after that.

- Consider a flashlight or flashing keychain/band if your child is wearing all dark clothing on dark mornings.
