

SCHOOL DISTRICT ORGANIZATION

Governance

The trustees of the District shall participate on an equal basis with other members in all transactions pertaining to the High Schools maintained by the District. Only the trustees elected from Elementary District may participate in decisions pertaining to the elementary school district. Official action of the Board may only occur at a duly called and legally conducted meeting. A “meeting” is defined as the convening of a quorum of the constituent membership of the Board, whether in person or by means of electronic equipment, to hear, discuss, or act upon a matter over which the Board has supervision, control, jurisdiction or advisory power.

There may be student delegates selected by the Board of Trustees from each High School to be the non-voting representatives of the student body. The student representatives may attend all regular and special Board meetings.

Individual school board members have no authority over school affairs, except as provided by law or as authorized by the Board.
