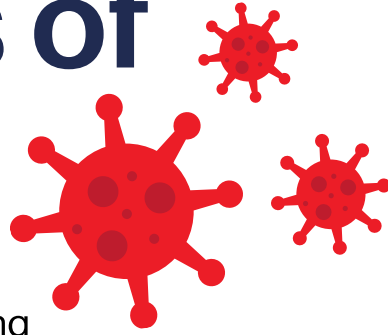


# Symptoms of COVID-19



- Cough (new or unexplained)
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- New loss of taste or smell
- Temperature greater than or equal to 100.4 F or chills
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Fatigue
- Congestion or runny nose (new or unexplained)



## Not all symptoms of illness mean someone has COVID-19.

The following symptoms may indicate a SUSPECT CASE of COVID-19. School staff may consult LPH for further guidance.

Any **ONE** symptom

OR

Any **TWO** symptoms

- Cough (new or unexplained)
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- New loss of taste or smell
- Temperature greater than or equal to 100.4 F or chills
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Fatigue

## When to call for emergency care:

A person with the following symptoms needs emergency medical attention. **Call 911** and notify the operator that you are seeking care for someone who may have COVID-19.

- Difficulty breathing
- Persistent pain or pressure in chest
- New confusion
- Inability to wake or stay awake
- Bluish lips or face

\*This list does not reflect all possible symptoms requiring emergency care.
