ORDER FOR CORRECTIVE ACTION

Pursuant to Title 50, Chapter 2, Part 1, and specifically Section 50-2-116 and 50-2-118 of the Montana Code Annotated, Title 50, Chapter 1, Part 2, and specifically Section 50-1-202(2)(a) of the Montana Code Annotated, the Governor's Executive Orders 2-2020 and 3-2020, and the April 22, May 8, and May 19, 2020 Governor's Directive implementing Executive Orders 2-2020 and 3-2020, the Lewis and Clark City-County Health Officer issued an Order of the Health Officer on April 22 and May 21, 2020, adopting the Directives of the Governor of the State of Montana establishing conditions for Phase One and Phase Two. Additionally, the Governor issued a July 15, 2020 Directive requiring the mandatory use of face coverings in certain settings. The Lewis and Clark City-County Health Officer issued an Order of the Health Officer 11-2020 adopting the Governor's Directive requiring face coverings and an Order 10-2020 last amended on September 3, 2020 stating requirements for event gatherings including school sporting events.

On September 14, 2020, Lewis and Clark Public Health received notice of a **lack of compliance with the Order at a Helena School District (HSD) 1 sporting event**. On September 17, 2020, Laura Hendley, RS contacted Tim McMahon by email to provide information regarding the complaint. Education related to the meaning, intent, and force of the Order and the importance of adherence to the Order had previously been discussed during meetings between Lewis and Clark Public Health and Helena School District 1. **Subsequently, on September 28, 2020, Lewis and Clark Public Health was notified of a second complaint regarding lack of compliance with the Order at an HSD sporting event.**

Pursuant to the above, **YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED** to take the following corrective action:

- Require physical distancing of at least 6 feet for spectators at HSD sporting events.
- Require use of face coverings for all spectators at HSD sporting events.
- Submit a new plan or an addendum to the existing plan detailing how these requirements will be met.

Registered Sanitarians with Lewis and Clark Public Health are available for further consult regarding this Order for Corrective Action.
