## I. CALL TO ORDER

Board Chair Siobhan Hathhorn called the meeting to order at 12:04 p.m.

## V. **NEW BUSINESS**

## A. Facilities Master Plan Update

Tim Meldrum, Partner + Principal with SMA Architects, gave an update on the Facilities Master Plan. Mr. Meldrum reviewed tasks accomplished in the last month. The SMA/NAC team continues to refine Master Planning options for district facilities at the elementary, middle school and high school levels. Their team along with the school district continues to discuss prioritization of projects and how these priorities inform phasing and potential bonds. Development of the master plan document is ongoing. The SMA/NAC team met with a focused group from the Helena School District on 08.16.2023 to continue discussion on school district goals and priorities and refinement of the master plan options to reach these. The group began looking at how these objectives would need to be phased over the course of multiple bonds to successfully realize the master plan. The SMA/NAC team has been gathering data to better understand the District's current sustainability methods and develop a framework for future sustainability goals/policy. Future sustainability goals/policy will be refined with the school district at the next monthly progress meeting on September 20<sup>th</sup>. The SMA team met with Trustees in a series of three meetings on September 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> to review work to date and discuss the elementary, middle school and high school options that have been developed. Looking ahead the SMA/NAC team will start meeting with Facilities Director Todd Verrill to prioritize the deferred maintenance spending as the Facilities Master Plan finds resolution. The SMA/NAC team continues Phase 2 of the Master Plan and based on the feedback received at the Helena School District focus meeting one and two, the SMA team will continue to develop and refine the master planning options for the elementary, middle, and high school facilities. Mr. Meldrum concluded his presentation by review the upcoming schedule, meetings, and deliverable status for the facilities master plan.
