#### C. RFQ For Smith Elementary HVAC Design and Project Management

At the November 12<sup>th</sup> full Board of Trustees meeting, Mr. Verill will be respectfully requesting the Board of Trustees approve Con'eer Engineering, Inc. for design and contract administration of a new HVAC system at Smith Elementary School. The cost of the design and contract administration services is \$180,300. The lead engineer is Mr. Gruizenga, PE who is very familiar with the school's current system as he contributed to the district's 2022 Deferred Maintenance Report. The report listed the Smith system's replacement as a high priority project due to its inefficiency and outdated design. The total estimated cost of the HVAC project is approximately \$2M, which includes the 10% design and contract administration service fees. The facilities office posted a Request for Qualifications for this project and Con'eer Engineering, Inc. was the only firm

to submit a packet. Having reviewed their statement of qualifications and proposed costs, Mr. Verrill is confident Con'eer is highly qualified, and their costs are reasonable and customary for this type of project. Mr. Verrill addressed all the questions posed by the Facilities and Technology Committee regarding the RFQ for Smith Elementary HVAC Design and Project Management.





### Helena High HVAC System



- HHS has one of two remaining steam systems in the district. It is serviced by three boilers (only two are operational). They have an efficiency of 45-55%.
- Many of the steam and return condensate pipes and fittings are failing





Estimated replacement cost: **\$7,000,000**
